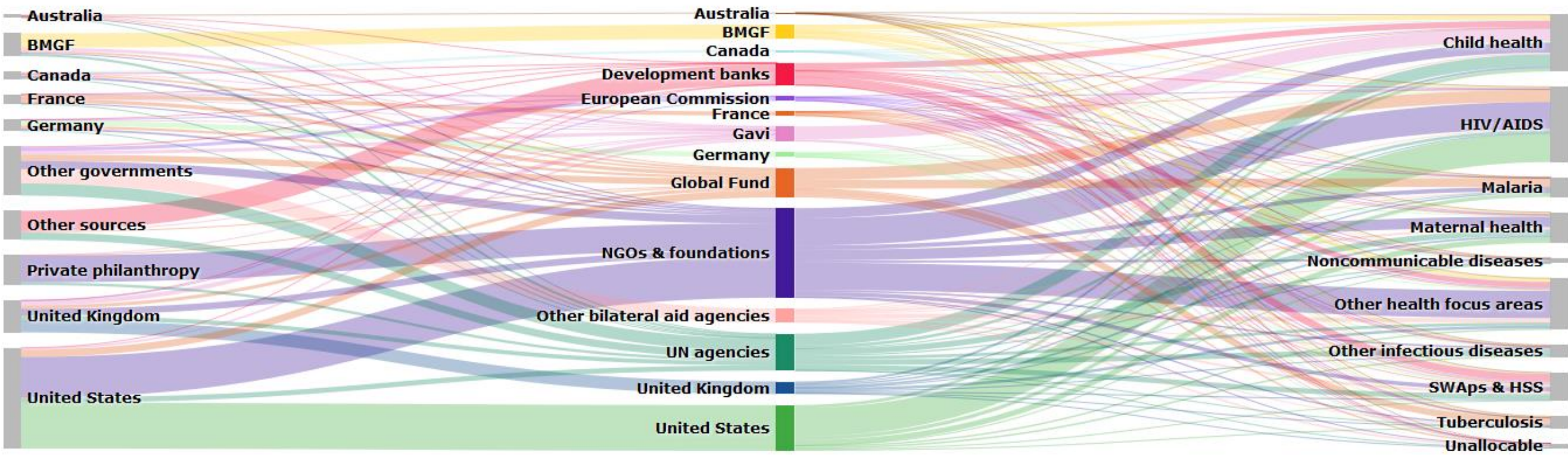
Flows of Global Health Financing

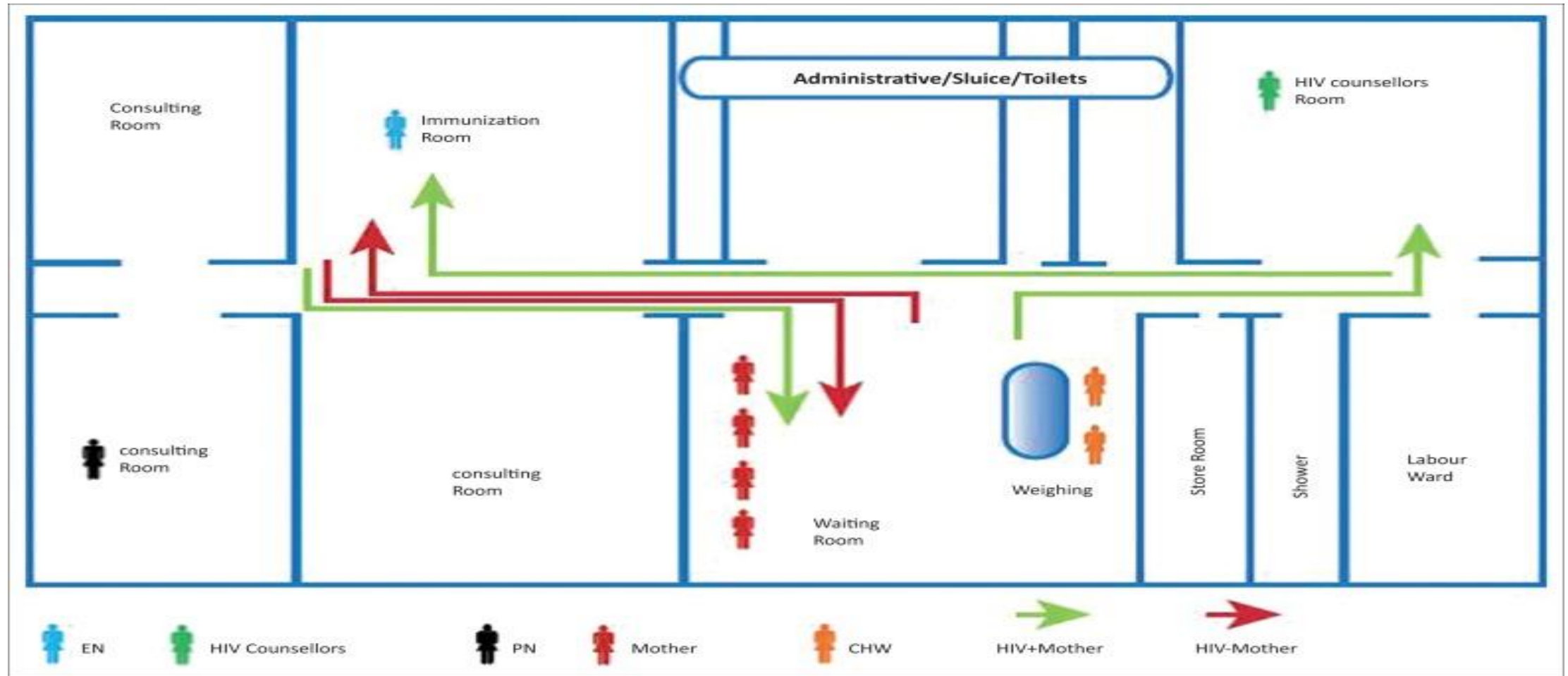

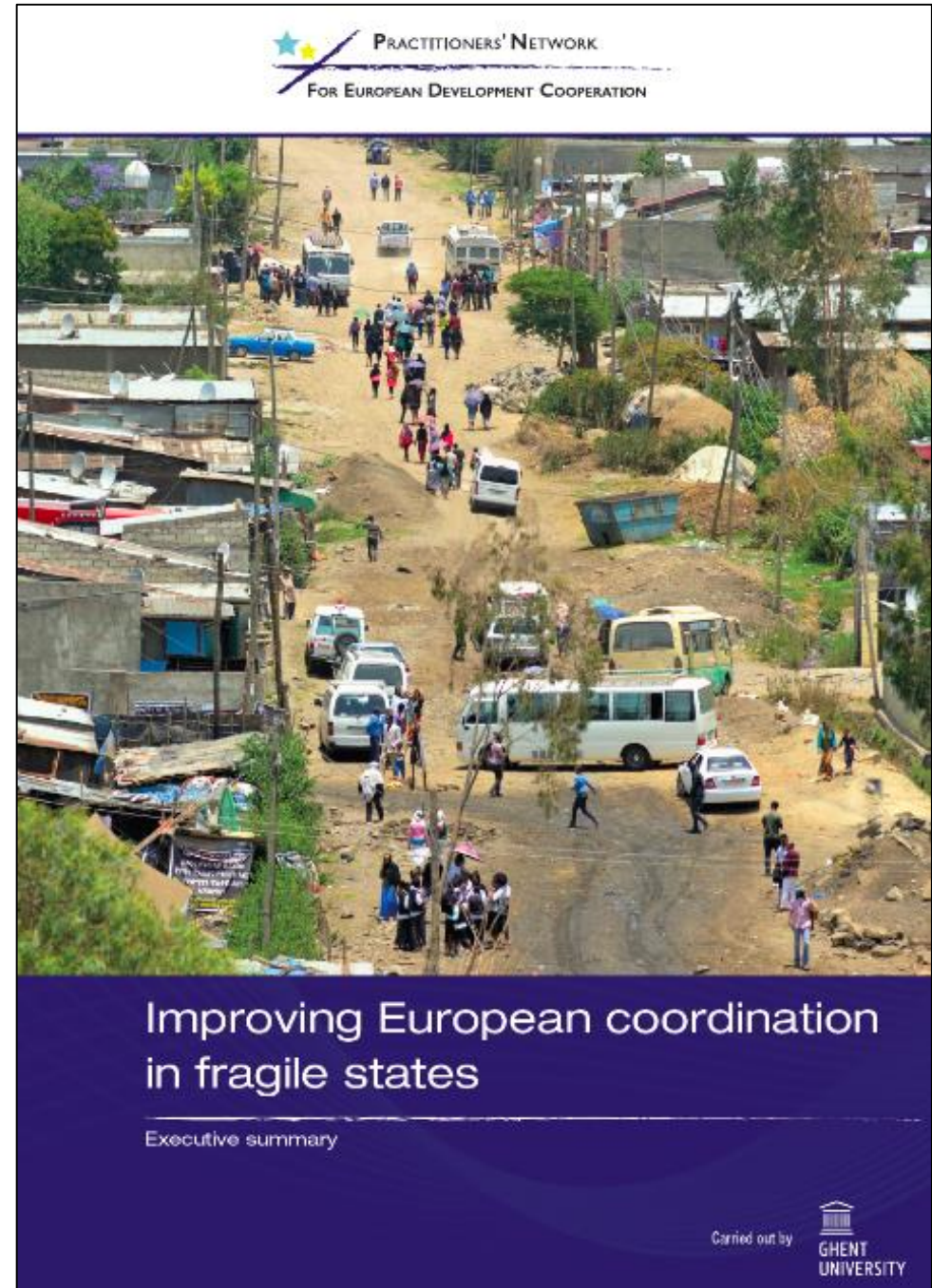

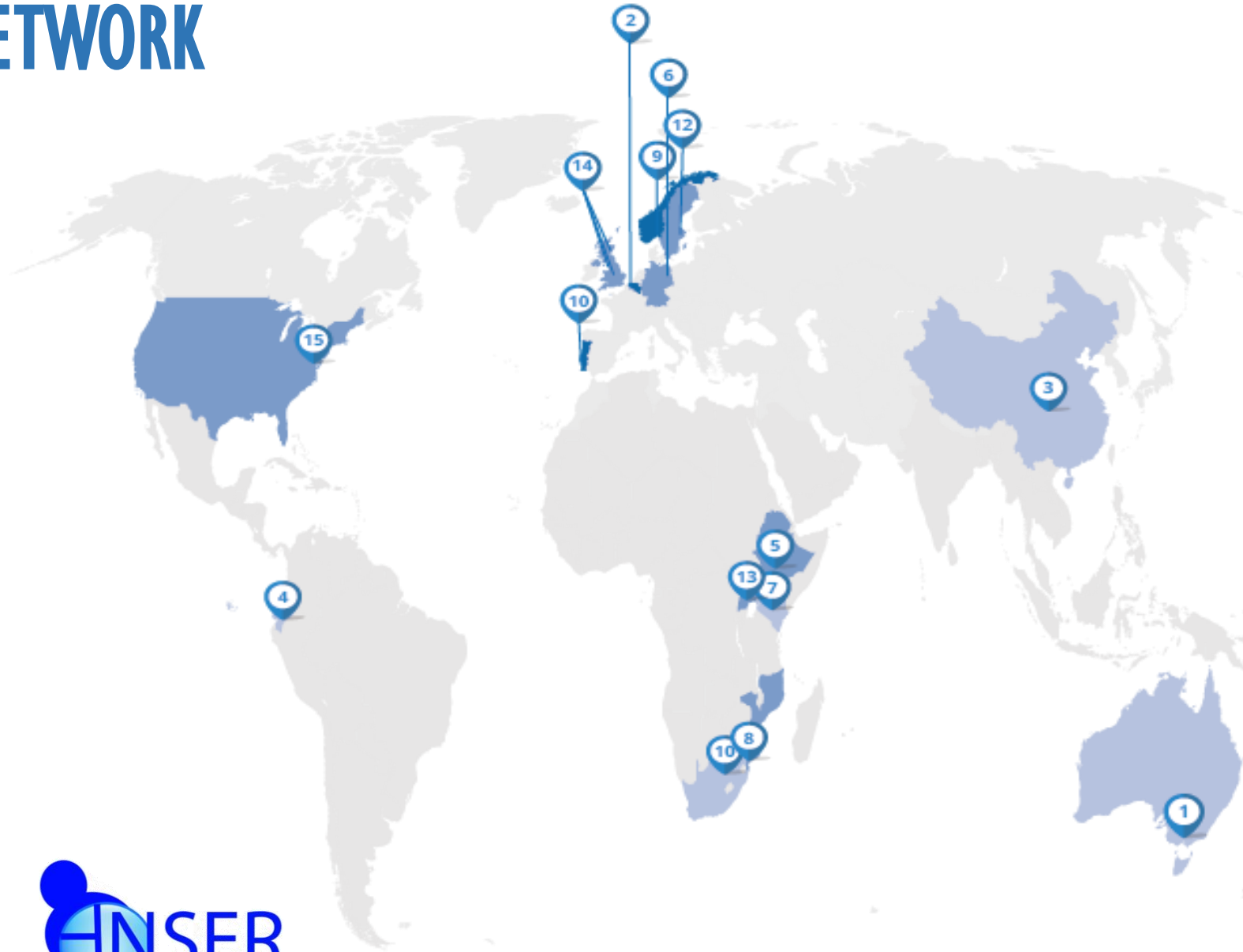
